FirstWorks announces 2016/2017 Artistic Icons Series

The non-profit driving force behind PVDFest carries the festival spirit through a series to engage audiences with the legacy and innovation of luminary American artists

Providence, RI — Now in its 12th year of connecting art with audiences, **FirstWorks** continues its legacy of bringing bold and brilliant performances to Rhode Island with its **2016/2017 Artistic Icons Series** at **The Vets**. The non-profit driving force behind Providence's PVDFest will engage audiences through performances and artist residencies featuring three luminary American artistic innovators across the genres of circus arts, hip-hop, and dance.

This season's Icons include **Cirque Mechanics**, who pedal back into Providence with their newest spectacle; the renowned **Rennie Harris Puremovement**, igniting the stage with the art and legacy of hip-hop; and the inimitable **Paul Taylor Dance Company**, whose **FirstWorks** residency culminates in the world premiere of a new work.

The 2016/2017 Artistic Icons Series launches at The Vets on October 29, 2016 at 7:30 p.m. with Cirque Mechanics' "Pedal Punk", a steampunk spectacle of stunning circus arts featuring a dazzling whirl of acrobats, cyclists and mind-blowing, one-of-a-kind machines.

FirstWorks surpasses their reputation for "firsts" in dance by bringing Paul Taylor, arguably America's most important living choreographer, to Rhode Island for a multi-month residency and the world-premiere of a new work.
